GOD CLEANSSES US IN CHRIST *(Please be seated)*

Leader: Let us hear together the Word of God regarding our new lives in Christ: “Now if we have died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him. We know that Christ, being raised from the dead, will never die again; death no longer has dominion over

him. For the death he died he died to sin, once for all, but the life he lives, he lives to God. So you must consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus. Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, to make you obey its passions. For sin will have no dominion over you, since you are not under law but under grace.” (Romans 6:8-12,14)

Leader: In light of God’s Word, let us confess our sins:

Minister: People of God, lift up your heads and stand with me to hear the good news of our salvation: *(Please stand)*

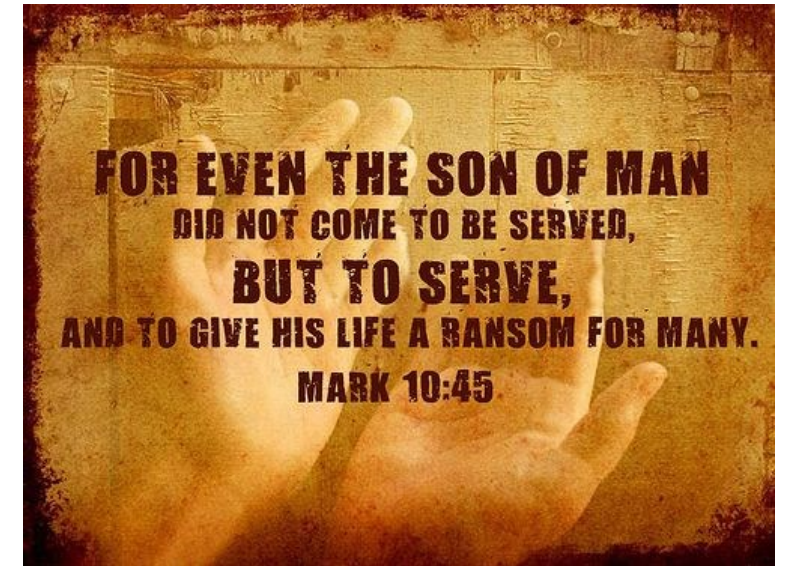
