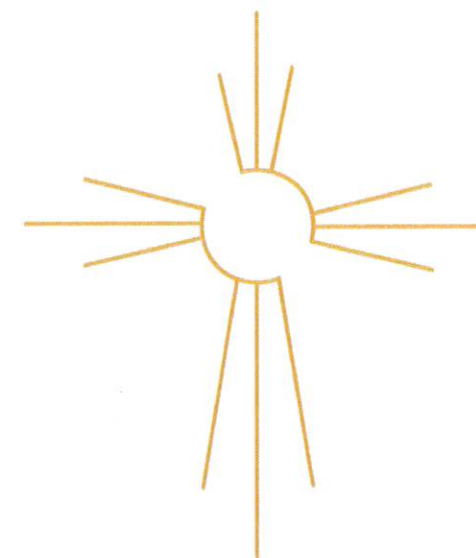

GOD CLEANSSES US IN CHRIST (Please be seated)

Leader: Let us read together the Law of God. **(see insert)**

Leader: People of God, "*What is the sum of the Ten Commandments?*" (Shorter Catechism Question #42 of the Westminster Confession of Faith)

Congregation: The sum of the Ten Commandments is, to love the Lord our God with all our heart, with all our soul, with all our strength, and with all our mind; and our neighbor as ourselves.

Leader: In the light of God's complete knowledge of our thoughts, words, and actions, let us confess our sins together:

Almighty God and Heavenly Father, You are rich in mercy to all who call upon You. Hear us as we come to You humbly confessing our sins; imploring Your mercy and forgiveness. We have broken Your holy laws by our deeds and by our words, and by the sinful affections of our hearts. We confess before You our disobedience and ingratitude, our pride and willfulness, and our failures and shortcomings toward You and toward our neighbor. Have mercy upon us, O Heavenly Father, and forgive us in Christ. Out of Your great goodness grant that we may hereafter serve and please You in newness of life, as You have united us to Jesus Christ our Lord through faith. Amen.

Leader: Please take a moment to privately commune with our Lord, confessing any specific sins of which you are aware.

Minister: People of God, lift up your heads and stand with me to hear the good news of our salvation. (Please Stand)

"...and hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us. For while we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. For one will scarcely die for a righteous person – though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die – but God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
