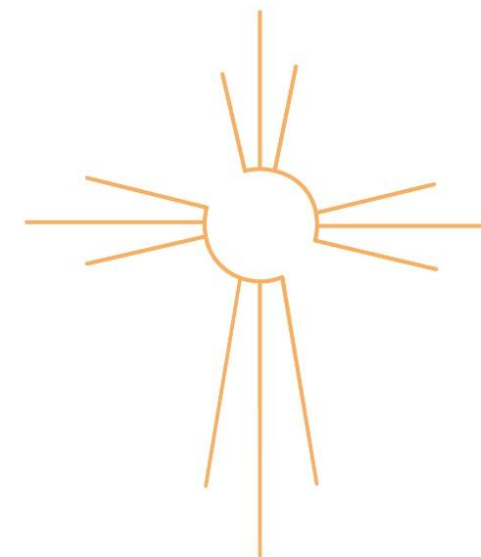

GOD CLEANSSES US IN CHRIST (Please be seated)

Leader: Let us hear the Word of God regarding the righteous character of our new lives in Christ.

"If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth. For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. When Christ who is your life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory. Leader: In the light of God's complete knowledge of our thoughts, words, and actions, let us confess our sins together:

So move, I pray, upon this disordered heart of mine. I acknowledge before You my unruly desires and selfish lusts. There also exists within me the mist and darkness of unbelief, causing me not to pursue righteousness with zeal, nor worship You aright. Brighten my soul now with the pure light of Your Truth. I confess my sins before You. I haven't loved You with my whole heart, nor have I loved my neighbor as myself. Forgive me through Christ's completed work of making purification for my sins and carry on Your work of making my life fragrant as the garden of paradise, rich with every goodly fruit, beautiful with heavenly grace, and radiant with rays of Your Divine Light. Help me to find in Christ's death the reality and immensity of Your love for me and enable me to walk humbly and confidently in that love. For it is in Christ's Name I pray, Amen.

Leader: Please take a moment to privately commune with our Lord, confessing any specific sins of which you are aware.

Minister: People of God, lift up your heads and stand with me to hear the good news of our salvation. (Please Stand)
