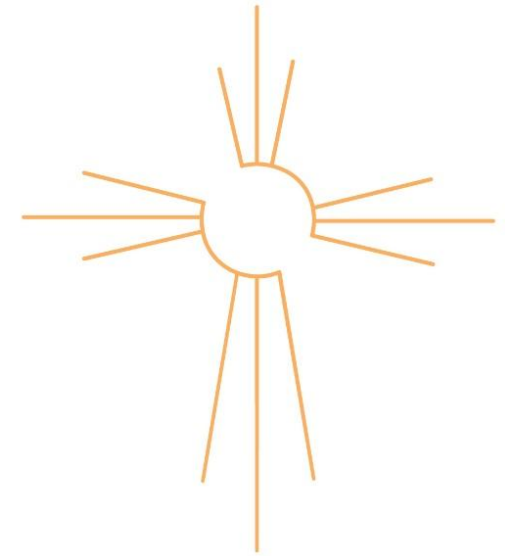

GOD CLEANSSES US IN CHRIST (Please be seated)

Leader: Let us hear the Word of God regarding the righteous character of our new lives in Christ.

"Beloved, I urge you as sojourners and exiles to abstain from the passions of the flesh, which wage war against your soul. Keep your conduct among the Gentiles honorable, so that when they speak evil against you as evildoers, they may see your good deeds and glorify God on the day of visitation. Be subject for the Lord's sake to every human institution, whether it be to the emperor as supreme, or to governors as sent by him to

The thoughts of my mind, the words of mouth, and the deeds of my hands have not been in conformity to Your Holy and Righteous Law. Forgive me and go on with Your work in my life. I reckon myself dead to sin and alive to You through my union with Your Son, Jesus Christ, the King of glory. Your promise to finish the good work You have started in my life is my great comfort. Through Your Word and Holy Spirit, cause me to walk worthy of the calling which I have received.

Leader: Please take a moment to privately commune with our Lord, confessing any specific sins of which you are aware.

Minister: People of God, lift up your heads and stand with me to hear the good news of our salvation. (Please Stand)
