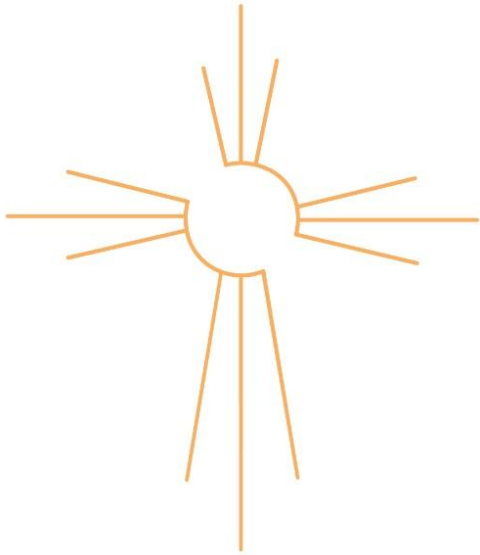

Leader: Let us hear the Word of God regarding the righteous character of our new lives in Christ.

Father, through Your Spirit and Word, cause me to walk in newness of life. Help me to realize again today what Christ has done for me that I might walk in peace and comfort in the knowledge of His love which will sustain me in times of trial. In Christ's Name I pray. Amen.
