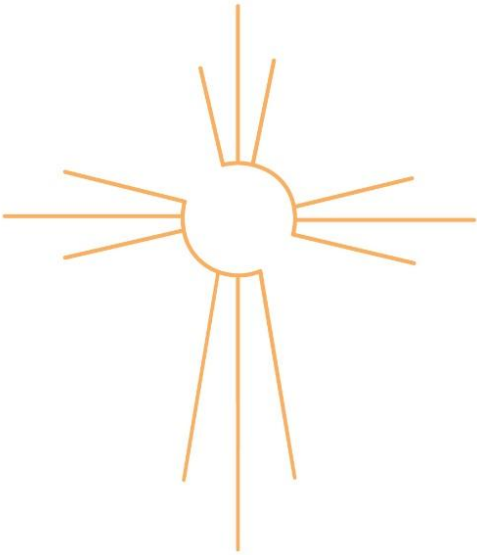

GOD CLEANSSES US IN CHRIST

(Please be seated)

Leader: Let us hear the Word of God regarding the righteous character of our new lives in Christ.

Speak to each of us the word that we need, and let Your word abide with us until it has wrought in us Your holy will. Amen.

Leader: Please take a moment to privately commune with our Lord, confessing any specific sins of which you are aware.

Minister: People of God, lift up your heads and stand with me to hear the good news of our salvation. (Please Stand)
